Psychodrama is an active form of group psychotherapy which utilizes guided dramatic action to examine problems or issues. Using experiential methods, sociometry, role theory and group dynamics, psychodrama facilitates insight, personal growth and integration on cognitive, affective and behavioral levels.

This workshop will explore the theory behind this dynamic approach as well as the essential elements in psychodrama. Also, specific techniques will be demonstrated that can be integrated into non-psychodrama groups.
